

SUPPORTING THE NEXT GENERATION OF SCIENTISTS

The Québec City Convention Centre and Québec City's Ambassadors' Club are offering financial support to encourage the next generation of scientists to attend their North American and international conferences. Through the program, faculty and researchers will be able to register ten of their students for their association's conference and have the registration fees reimbursed.

The program was created in collaboration with the Council of Engineering and Scientific Society Executives (CESSE), which brings together over 200 North American scientific organizations.

Eligible clientele:

Professors and researchers of member organizations of the Council of Engineering and Scientific Society Executives (CESSE) - www.cesse.org

Markets

- North American conferences: clientele where at least 30% of attendees are outside Canada
- International conferences: clientele from two or more countries other than Canada and the U.S., where at least 30% of the attendees are outside Canada
- 300 attendees minimum
- 3 days minimum

Amounts

- January to April, July and August, December: \$10 per attendee
- May and June, September to November: \$7.50 per attendee
- Authorized maximum: \$7,500
- A maximum of ten students may be registered

Eligible expenses

- The funds allocated must be used to register students for the conference.

Note

- Only expenses incurred after the request for support has been accepted will be considered for reimbursement.
- Registration fees will only be reimbursed upon submission of supporting documents.
